Janet Ann Augustine Siefkas, age 84 of Louisiana, passed away Friday June 21, 2019 at St. Luke's Hospital in Chesterfield, MO.

A fellowship gathering will be held at 1:00 pm Sunday June 23, 2019 at the Providence Concord Presbyterian Church in Vera, MO with a memorial service at 2:30 pm.

Janet was born October 14, 1934 in Creston, IA, the daughter of Benjamin and Grace Hanson Augustine. She grew up in Creston and attended school in Orient, IA.
