Marion George Meier, age 84, of Bowling Green, passed away Wednesday, August 16, 2017 at his home.

Funeral services will be held at 10:00 am on Saturday, August 19, at the Bibb-Veach Funeral Home in Bowling Green, MO with Rev. Don Amelung officiating. Burial will be in the Wellsville City Cemetery with military honors being conducted by the Missouri Military Honor Guard, Bowling Green VFW Post #5553 and the Patriot Guard Riders. Visitation will be held from 4:00pm until 7:00pm on Friday at the funeral home.
