Alan Louis Salfen, age 67, of Ashley, Missouri, passed away peacefully on Sunday, April 12, 2020 at the VA Hospital in Columbia, Missouri with his family by his side.

Family graveside services will be held at St. Clement Cemetery in St. Clement, Missouri with Deacon Mark Dobelman officiating. A memorial mass and service will be held at a later date.

Alan was born July 18, 1952 in St. Charles, Missouri, the son of Elroy Gregory and Virginia Kuester Salfen.

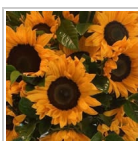
