Amber Nicole Martin, age 41, of Coralville, IA and formerly of Bowling Green, MO, passed away unexpectedly Friday, January 16, 2026.

A memorial service will be held at a later date. Services are under the direction of Bibb-Veach Funeral Homes in Bowling Green.

Amber was born November 8, 1984, in Louisiana, MO. She grew up in Pike County and attended school in the Bowling Green R-1 School system, where she played Volleyball for the BGHS Lady Cats. Upon graduating in 2003, Amber attended Truman State University where she earned her bachelor's degree. She was currently in the process of earning her master's degree in medical laboratory science from the University of Cincinnati.

Growing up, Amber attended Mt. Zion Baptist Church in rural Bowling Green. She enjoyed reading, painting, crafting and riding her bike.

From March of 2013, until August of 2025, Amber worked as a lead medical laboratory scientist at Quincy Medical Group, in Quincy, IL. She recently moved to Coralville, IA in September, where she accepted a position as a medical laboratory scientist supervisor in microbiology at the University of Iowa Health Center.

Amber is survived by her birth mother Angie Herman; parents James (Jim) Morton and wife Susan of Bowling Green; sister Ashley Squires and extended family. She was preceded in death by her great-grandparents Milo and Darline Morton, as well as Ollie and Leon Madison.

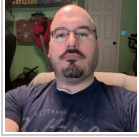

I miss, even in our 40s, having a chill hangout/puzzle night with her. I miss getting excited together over some stupid project or toy we bought to stay up all night playing with.

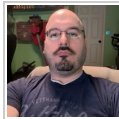

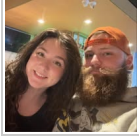
