



Bonnie Sue Ingram

December 21, 1933 - May 12, 2024

Bonnie Sue Ingram, 90, of Bowling Green, passed away May 12, 2024, at Lynn's Heritage House in Louisiana, Missouri.

Funeral services for Bonnie will be held Tuesday, May 21, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. at Second Baptist Church in Bowling Green with Pastor Mark West and Pastor Don Amelung officiating. Burial will be in Memorial Gardens Cemetery in Bowling Green. Visitation will be Monday, May 20, 2024 from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at Bibb-Veach Funeral Homes and Crematory in Bowling Green.

Bonnie was born December 21, 1933 in Bowling Green to Purley Lee and Nellie (Inlow) Lewis. She was united in marriage to Donald Zane Ingram on June 30, 1951. Donald preceded her in death on November 30, 1999.

Bonnie grew up around McCune Station and lived in the Bowling Green area her entire life. On January 1, 1954, Bonnie and Donald began Ingram Plumbing, where she worked for over 50 years.

Bonnie was a member of the Second Baptist Church in Bowling Green where she was a Sunday School teacher and served on the Executive Board of Salt River Baptist Association. Bonnie enjoyed her family; especially her grandchildren. She also enjoyed reading, mowing the lawn, going to the family farm, and studying genealogy. She took joy in lifting others up in prayer. She

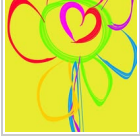
