Bradly Lee Rubemeyer of New London, Missouri passed away peacefully on July 26, 2023 at his home.

Bradly was born September 25, 1969 at Pike County Memorial Hospital in Louisiana, Missouri to Lynda (Anderson) Rubemeyer and Raymond (“Mickey”) Rubemeyer. He knew what was on the menus and what he liked at each place. Bradly didn’t know a stranger. It was not unusual for him to go up to a stranger and start talking to them.

Bradly lived in New London at a home facility for the mentally challenged. Bradly loved each and every one that cared for him there. They, too, were his

family.
