



## Catherine "Sue" Haley

April 29, 1953 - January 13, 2024

Catherine "Sue" Haley, 70, of Bowling Green, died Saturday, January 13, 2024 at her home in Bowling Green, Missouri. Sue was born April 29, 1953 in St. Charles, Missouri and adopted by Frances Fitzgerald Haley and J.D. Haley. She was preceded in death by her parents.

Funeral services for Sue will be held Wednesday, January 17, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. at Bibb-Veach Funeral Homes and Crematory with Rebecca Glenn officiating. Burial will be in Bowling Green Cemetery. Visitation will be held from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday at the funeral home.

Ms. Haley was educated in the Bowling Green public schools and graduated from Bowling Green High School in 1971. She attended college at William Woods University where she graduated in 1975 with a degree in Education and a minor in History.

She taught school for 20 years in the Bowling Green school system, both at Curryville and Bowling Green Elementary Schools. She also coached volleyball at the high school for 18 years.

After her teaching career she owned and operated an antique and collectible shop called The Garden Gate, in Bowling Green.

She had served on the board of the Twin Pike YMCA during its formation and was a member of the Chapter DA of the PEO Sisterhood.

She enjoyed collecting antiques and traveling, and had traveled throughout the United States and to several European countries.

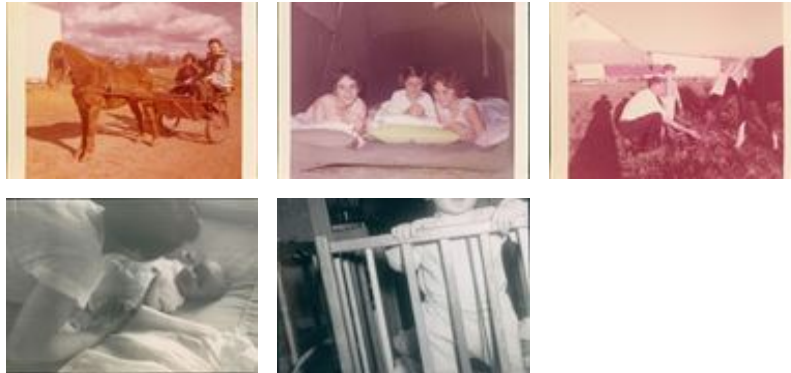
