Cindy Christensen age 55, of Bowling Green passed away May 13, 2014 at the Pike County Memorial Hospital.

Funeral services will be held 10:00 a.m., Saturday, May 17, 2014 at the Mudd-Veach Funeral Home in Bowling Green with Rev. Robert Warren officiating. Interment will be in the Memorial Gardens Cemetery in Bowling Green. Visitation will be held 4:00 – 8:00 p.m. Friday, May 16, 2014 at the funeral home.

Cindy was born May 7, 1959 in Hannibal the daughter of Charles Eugene and Ila P. Wyatt Anderson. She married Ronald J. Christensen December 29, 1984 at the Nazarene Church in Hannibal. He survives. Above all she loved her children and her family.
