Daniel Lee Galloway, 56, of Hannibal, Mo., died on April 14, 2015, at his home.

Mr. Galloway was born April 16, 1958, in Columbia to Robert E. and Lilie A. Galloway.

He was married to Wanda Sue Wegener on June 22, 1979. She faithfully and lovingly provided for his daily care throughout his long battle with cancer. In his own words, “Wanda was God’s greatest blessing and gift” to Dan.

Other survivors include his son, Robert Lee Galloway (Meryle) of Creve Coeur; his sister, Lisa Haney (Ed) of Kearny; and his parents in Hannibal.

He was a graduate of William Jewell College in 1979, and completed graduate studies at Wolfson College, University of Cambridge, England. He worked for Galloway Limestone Co. with his family until co-founding Galloway & Galloway, an investment advisory firm, in 1989, where he worked until health issues caused him to retire in 2009.

He served as board chair of Hannibal Regional Hospital and also served on the boards of MCM Bank, Kid’s Wall Street News magazine and the Bowling Green School Board. He volunteered on numerous other state and local boards.

There will be no services or memorials, per his request. The Bibb-Veach Funeral Home in Bowling Green is in charge of arrangements.

Dan was a member of the Tea Party Patriots. He dreamed of the elimination of a tyrannical federal government, a return to the Founder’s view of an America based on Personal Liberty and Freedom. He was also a proponent of a Free and Independent Scotland.
