Dareyl Wayne Nalley, 63, of Columbia, formerly of Bowling Green, passed away Tuesday, May 16, 2023 at his home in Columbia, Missouri.

Funeral services for Dareyl will be held Monday, May 22, 2023 at 2:00 p.m. at Bibb-Veach Funeral Homes & Crematory with Pastor Josh Palmer officiating. Burial will be at Fairview Cemetery in Ashley, Missouri. Visitation will be Monday from 1:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m. at the funeral home.

Dareyl was born May 18, 1959 in Louisiana, Missouri to Hubert and Charlene (Williams) Nalley. He was united in marriage to Jane Nalley in 1999. Jane survives.

Dareyl was non-denominational in his Christian faith. He attended Destiny Pointe Church in Columbia where he was a very active pillar of the church; serving as an usher and a greeter. Dareyl enjoyed spending time with his family; especially his grandchildren and his many covenant children. He liked being around people, and always enjoyed meeting new people.
