David Hallows passed away on January 8th, 2026, after a life defined by hard work, long roads, and dedication to family & friends. He spent much of his life driving trucks, primarily hauling race and show horses across the country. Horses were more than just a job to him, they were a passion. He owned, rode, and trained horses for many years, finding pride and purpose in the work and the bond that came with it. Another passion of his was Country music. He worked as a local radio host at KPCR for several years becoming a familiar voice in the community known as “Country Dave.”

He was a cowboy in the truest sense not just by his beloved cowboy hat and boots, but how he lived. Outspoken, tough, and built like a cowboy, he lived by a code where right and wrong mattered, even the hard lessons stuck, and he was a true friend to anyone who needed one.

He raised four children and left a lasting influence on each of them through his love and lessons; some taught directly, others learned simply by watching him live his life.
