David William Aldin Nulsen, 76, of Eolia, passed away Thursday, June 24, 2021 at St. Joseph West Hospital in Lake St. Louis, Missouri.

Per David's wishes, a Memorial Service will be held at the family farm at a later date. Cremation rites are under the direction of Bibb-Veach Funeral Homes and Crematory of Bowling Green.

David was born November 5, 1944 in Eolia, Missouri to Albert George Nulsen III and Betty Isabelle Sullivan Nulsen; the seventh of eighteen children.
