Donald Jewell Reese, age 77, of Bowling Green, passed away June 29, 2015 at the Boone Hospital Center in Columbia.

A memorial graveside service will be held 11:00 a.m. Thursday, July 9, 2015 at the Louisville Cemetery with Rev. Don Amelung officiating. Military rites will be conducted by the Missouri Military Honors and the VFW post 5553.

Donald was born June 4, 1938 the son of Melvin J. and Anna B. Gillum Reese. On October 15, 1966 in Bowling Green he married Judy Thomas. She survives. Other survivors include son Shannon Reese and wife Chastity of Kansas City; daughter Amanda Reese of Bowling Green; grandchild Sabrina Reese of Kansas City; step-grandchild Emilee Phillips of Kansas City; sisters Selma Reese of Louisville and Margaret Ann Talbort of Bowling Green; and several nieces, nephews and cousins. He was preceded in death by his parents and a sister Emma Ruth Myers.

Donald lived in the Ashley area all his life, was a member of the Louisville Christian Church and a member of the American Legion Post 370 of Louisiana. He served in the Army from 1961 to 1963 during the Vietnam War, was a Farmall tractor collector and enjoyed many mornings drinking coffee at MeeMees.
