



## Dorothy May King

January 14, 1922 - July 23, 2015

Dorothy May King, 93, of Bowling Green passed away at her home Thursday July 23, 2015 with her daughter at her side.

Funeral services will be held Saturday July 25th at 11:00 am at the Bibb-Veach Funeral Home in Bowling Green with Rev. John Pinkston officiating. Visitation will held Saturday from 10:00 am until time of services. Graveside services will be held at 2:30 pm Saturday at the St. Charles Memorial Gardens Cemetery.

Dorothy was born on January 14, 1922 in Buell, the daughter of Robert Nathan and Sarah Belle VanEssler Stepp. She lived her childhood in St. Louis, Buell and Grassy. 

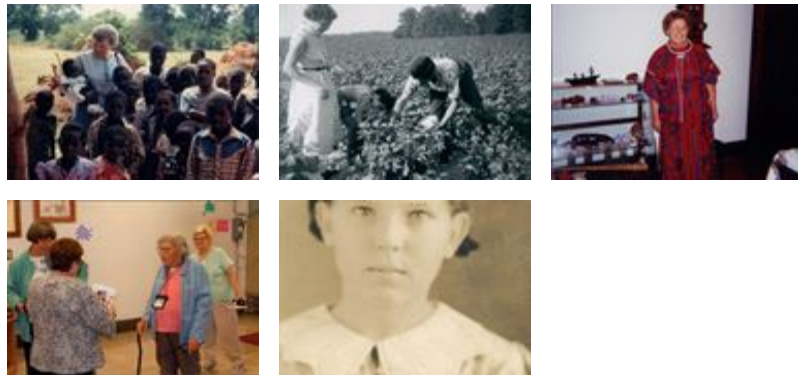
