Edmund "Ed" George Korte, 75, of Bowling Green, passed away Monday, August 15, 2022 at Missouri Baptist Hospital in St. Louis.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held Friday, August 19, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. at St. Clement Catholic Church with Fr. Lou Dorn officiating. Visitation for Ed will be on Thursday, August 18th from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at Bibb-Veach Funeral Homes & Crematory in Bowling Green.

Ed was born July 23, 1947 in Hannibal, Missouri to Edmund Herman and Celeste Schroeder Korte. He was united in marriage to Lois Sue Cragen on November 27, 1971 at St. Clement Church. She preceded him in death on June 9, 2011.
