Ernest "Ernie" Wm. Brown, 82, of Bowling Green, passed away Tuesday, March 11, 2025, at Country View Nursing Facility in Bowling Green.

Funeral services for Ernie will be Saturday, March 15, 2025, at 12:00 p.m. at Bibb-Veach Funeral Homes and Crematory in Bowling Green with Lay Pastor Chris Gamm officiating. Visitation will be Saturday, March 15th from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. at the funeral home.

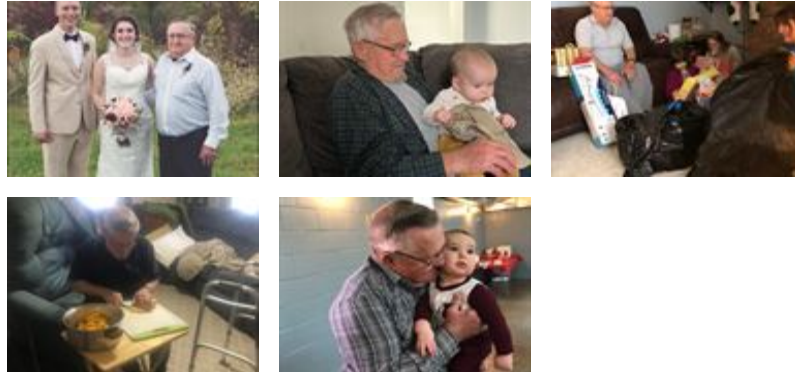
