Frank Henry Koster, age 81, of Silex, MO, passed away at his residence, Tuesday, February 3, 2026, with his wife by his side.

Funeral services will be held at 11:00am, Friday, February 6, 2026, at the Bibb-Veach Funeral Homes in Silex, MO with Pastor Steven Gamble officiating. Burial will be in the St. Alphonsus Cemetery in Silex. Visitation will be held from 10:00am until time of services on Friday at the funeral home.

Frank was born at his family's home in rural Silex, February 10, 1944, the son of Isaac Henry and Pearl (Welch) Koster. Born and raised in Silex, Frank attended Silex School until the age of 16 years old, when he left school to begin his first job working on cars for Remferd Mudd. Frank continued his working career for Bill Logan, Stanley Polman, Mick Mehler and Dick Thompson, before he began working on buses for Denny Miller, where he began working full time in 1985 and retired in 2015.

Frank married Bonnie Lee Overall on May 18, 1974, at the New Salem Baptist Church in Winfield, and together they raised a family that Frank was proud of. Frank became a Christian by accepting Jesus as his Lord and Savior in 2017 and was a follower of the Assembly of God faith. He enjoyed welding, working on cars and junking. His prize vehicle was a 1966 GTO that he painted red. In his free time, Frank enjoyed watching old westerns, especially John Wayne

movies, and listening to classic country music. He and Bonnie traveled to the PTL Club (Praise The Lord) in South Carolina and enjoyed camping.
