Fred A. Street Jr., age 90, of Silex passed away Monday, March 31, 2014 at his home.

Funeral services will be held at 11:00 a.m. Friday April 4, 2014 at the Whiteside Baptist Church, with Rev. Bill Patrick officiating. Burial will be at the Mill Creek Cemetery near Silex. Visitation will be 4:00 – 8:00 p.m., Thursday, April 3, 2014 at the Mudd-Veach Funeral Home in Bowling Green.
