Glen Dale Flowers, of Katy, Texas, formerly Curryville (Spencerburg), Missouri, passed away around 4:30a.m. on Monday morning, March 3rd, 2025.

He grew up in Havana, Illinois before serving as a firefighter in the United States Air Force in the 1950's.
