Guy Lynn Scott, 82, of Hannibal, passed away Thursday, September 10, 2020 at Beth Haven Nursing Home.

Funeral services for Guy will be held Tuesday, September 15, 2020 at 1:00 p.m. at Bibb-Veach Funeral Home in Bowling Green with Rev. Marvin Davis officiating. Visitation for Mr. Scott will be from 11:30 to the time of service. Burial will be in the Greenwood Cemetery in Clarksville, Missouri.
