Harriett Elizabeth Shepherd of Louisiana, formerly of Vandalia, passed away Saturday, June 6, 2020 at SSM DePaul Hospital in Bridgeton, Missouri.

Graveside services will be held at the Curryville Cemetery at 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 13, 2020.

Elizabeth was born on February 22, 1918 in Farber, Missouri to William Bryant Sr. and Ethel Jackson Bryant. They preceded her in death. She married Orey Shepherd on December 22, 1937. He preceded her in death on April 28, 2006.

Elizabeth was also preceded in death by 7 brothers and 2 sisters.

She is survived by 2 daughters; Beverly Florence of Bowling Green, and Betty Taylor (Alvin) of Davenport, Iowa; 8 grandchildren; 12 great-grandchildren; and many nieces, nephews, and cousins.

Elizabeth was a homemaker all of her life. She loved cooking and caring for her grandchildren, including “the cake that didn’t last”. She also enjoyed driving and shopping. 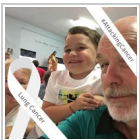
