



## Helen Rose Johnson

Helen Rose Johnson, age 98, of Eolia, Missouri, passed away at her home Sunday, October 27, 2024.

Funeral services will be held at 11:00am on Saturday, November 2, 2024, at the Bibb-Veach Funeral Homes & Crematory in Bowling Green, with Pastor Murray Phillips officiating. Burial will be in Edgewood Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Saturday from 9:00am until the time of services at the funeral home.

Helen was born April 15, 1926, in Swede Town, just outside of Bowling Green and lived in Pike County her entire life. 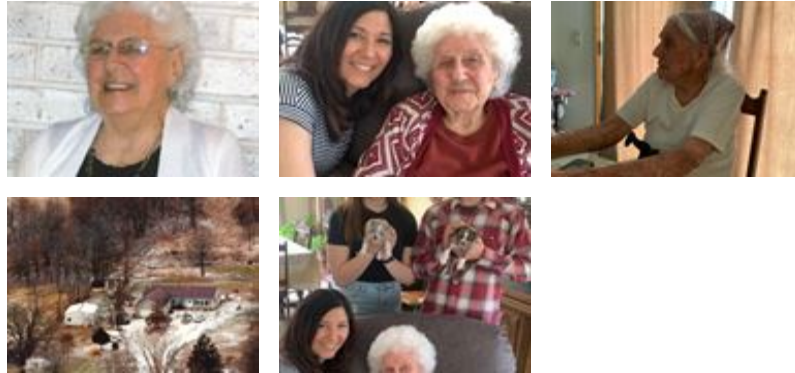
