



## Henry James "Jim" Leverenz III

Henry James "Jim" Leverenz III, 88, of Bowling Green, passed away Monday, November 27, 2023 at Country View Nursing Facility in Bowling Green.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held Wednesday, November 29, 2023 at 11:00 a.m. at St. Clement Catholic Church with Fr. Lou Dorn officiating. Burial will be in St. Clement Catholic Cemetery. Visitation will be held Wednesday from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. at the church.

Jim was born May 6, 1935 in St. Charles, Missouri to Henry George and Leona Emma (Swatner) Leverenz. He was united in marriage to Marie Frances Molitor on May 30, 1956 at the Assumption Church in O'Fallon, Missouri. Marie survives.
