James "Jim" William Scherder, age 85 of Bowling Green, passed away Monday, September 14, 2015 in his home.

Visitation will be held from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Thursday, September 17 at Bibb-Veach Funeral Home in Bowling Green. Funeral services will be on September 18 at 10:00 a.m. at St. Clement Catholic Church with Rev. Robert W. Peckman officiating. Burial will be in the St. Clement Cemetery with full military honors being conducted by VFW Post # 5553 and the Missouri Military Honors Team from Jefferson Barracks.

Jim was born on August 12, 1930 in St. Clement, MO, the son of Fred and Eleanor (Orf) Scherder.

He married JoAnn Feldmann on November 4, 1961 at St. Clement Catholic Church. She survives. Jim served in the United States Army from 1952-1953 and was a Sergeant First Class. He was a veteran of the Korean War and served nine months on

the front lines. He received numerous citations and honors for his military service.

Jim lived and farmed all his life in Bowling Green. He was always good-hearted and willing to give others a helping hand. He loved being a farmer and was known for his knowledge of cattle. Later in life, he enjoyed his morning coffee with his friends at Feeder's Grain and Friday cattle sales at the Sale Barn.

He was an active member of the St. Clement Church, Knights of Columbus, and VFW. He enjoyed playing cards, working on the farm, and watching the St. Louis Cardinals. Most of all, he enjoyed watching his kids and grandkids play sports and do activities.

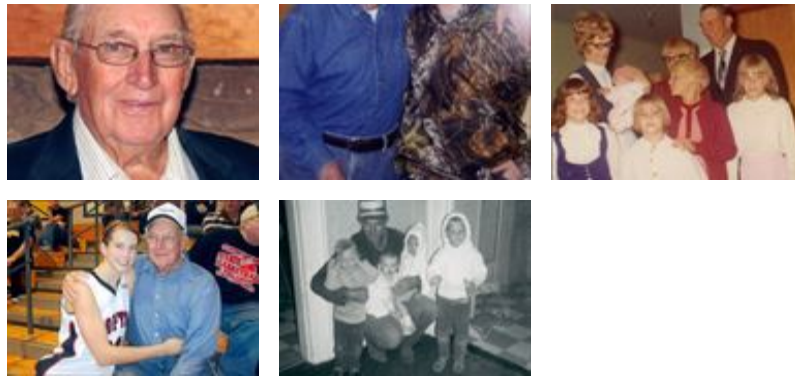

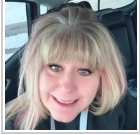
