Jane Ann McGeorge passed away on April 27, 2025.

Memorial services will be Tuesday, May 6, 2025, from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at Bibb-Veach Funeral Homes and Crematory in Bowling Green.

Jane was born September 20, 1940, in Mexico, Missouri, the daughter of Bob and Merle (Fry) McKee of Vandalia, Missouri.

She attended 1st and 2nd grade at Farber School, moving to Bowling Green in 1948. She was a graduate of Bowling Green High School with the class of 1958. She married Edwin McGeorge on January 25, 1958, and they lived in Lawton, Oklahoma while Ed was in the service until 1960 at which time they moved back to Bowling Green where they lived until her death.

Jane worked in the office of Dr. Jack Griffen from 1963 until 1995. She continued to work in the same office, then owned by Pike County Memorial Hospital, until her retirement in 2002. She was a member of the Second Baptist Church in Bowling Green, a past member of the Jaycee Wives, and the Business Professional Women's Club.

She loved spending time with her family and friends and playing cards at the casino. She was a loving wife, mother, sister, grandmother, and great-

grandmother.
