





He and his wife owned and operated Hogan's Hickory Hill Beefalo Farm and was a member of the American Beefalo Association.

The Hogans were selected as the 2013 Lincoln County Farm Family of the year. He was a member of St. Alphonsus Catholic Church and Millwood Knights of Columbus Council #2009. Jeffrey was good with his hands and could make anything. He loved hunting, fishing and skeet shooting, in which he won many awards. He also loved cooking and barbequing, especially for large gatherings. Most of all, Jeffrey loved his family and friends, and they adored him.
