Joan Marjorie (Stinn) Nehring, 86, of Bowling Green, Missouri, formally Grandview, Missouri, passed away Tuesday, July 28, 2020.

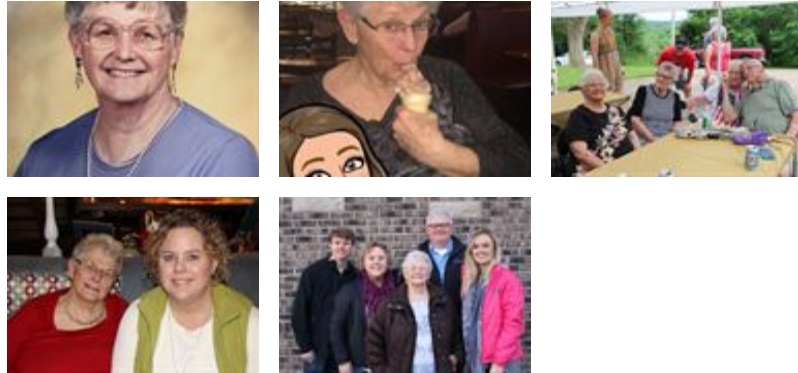
