November 18, 1949 - May 27, 2022

Kenneth Howard Everhart, 72, of Bowling Green, Mo passed away on May 27, 2022, after a lengthy battle with heart disease.

On November 18, 1949, Kenneth Howard Everhart was born to his parents Charles & Lily Mae (Curry) Everhart of Van Buren, MO, where he grew up and attended school. Upon his graduation from Van Buren High School, he went to service in the United States Army, where he was a Crew Chief of Helicopter Operations.

In 1973, while working for the Mo Department of Transportation-Highway Division, painting and sandblasting bridges, he met the love of his life Sandra Louise Perkins. They were united in marriage on Friday, March 15, 1974.
