Dr. Kevin J. Martin. Age 50, of Bowling Green, passed away Thursday, August 4, 2016 at his residence. Memorial services will be held at 2:00 pm on Saturday, August 13, 2016 at the Bibb-Veach Funeral Home in Bowling Green.

Kevin was born October 19, 1965 in Mexico, MO, the son of Allen Joseph Martin and Frances Jean Wilson. He married Adrienne Nicole Eby and together they had one son.
