



## Larry Wayne Dean

Larry Wayne Dean, 79, of Bowling Green, passed away Friday, February 18, 2022 at Pike County Memorial Hospital in Louisiana, Missouri.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held Thursday, March 10, 2022 at St. Clement Catholic Church at 10:00 a.m. with Fr. Henry Ussher officiating. Burial will be at St. Clement Cemetery. Visitation for Larry will be Thursday, March 10th from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. at St. Clement Catholic Church.

Larry was born January 26, 1943 to Orville and Margaret Digiovanni Dean. He was united in marriage to Catherine Joan Patricia Huettenmoser on December 31, 2003 in Nigril, Jamaica, and two weeks later at Holy Rosary Church in Warrenton, Missouri. Cathy survives.
