



## Larry Albert Grote

May 30, 1943 - November 18, 2023

Larry Albert Grote, age 80 of rural Bowling Green, was reunited with his beloved wife Cathy on November 18, 2023. Funeral services will be held Wednesday, November 22, at the St. Clement Catholic Church with visitation 9-11:00 and mass to follow.

Larry was born May 30, 1943, on the family farm in Ashley. He was the only son of Bernice (Orf) and Albert Grote. He attended elementary school there in Ashley and junior/high school in Bowling Green, graduating in 1961. On April 8, 1967, he married Catherine Mae York at the Catholic Church in Elsberry. They made their home in Ashley, where they raised their four daughters. He is survived by these daughters, their spouses, and grandchildren: Felicia and Tim Gamm, Hannah, Jessica, Breanne, and Chloe Kroencke, Noah and Avery Gamm; Tina and Roy Niemeyer, Loren, Kimberly, and Megan; Melinda and Jason Kneib and Bryleigh; Angela and Ben Eckler, Carissa, Delci, and Ellis.

Larry was preceded in death by his parents, his wife, and his son-in-law, Jon Kroencke.

Larry instilled in his children and grandchildren the value of hard work as he himself worked at Galloway and Magruder Limestone for over 40 years while also raising hogs and a few cattle at the family farm. He found solace in the simple joys of life—sitting outside under a shade tree, going to church, or

praying the rosary. He had an incredible memory and could retell stories with family and friends with a voice that always let you know he was in the room. While able, he always tried to get to a ball game or recital when his grandchildren were involved.

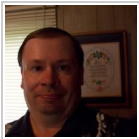

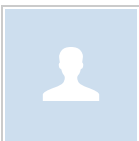
