Lionel Eugene Warren, 82, of Clarksville, passed away Friday, December 17, 2021 at Maple Grove Lodge in Louisiana.

Lionel was born October 6, 1939 in Eolia, Missouri to Cholie Colbert Warren and Marguerite E. Robinson.

Lionel grew up and lived in the Eolia and Clarksville area his entire life. He attended Lincoln School in Louisiana, as well as Clopton School in Clarksville. He was drafted into the U. S. Army during Vietnam.

Lionel was a member of the American Legion-Louisiana Post, the Clarksville Boat Club, and was a Teamster. He was employed at Transwood Trucking Company in Clarksville for 32 years, retiring in 2005.
