Lorraine "Bee" Meyer, age 85, of Bowling Green passed away surrounded by her family Wednesday, November 13, 2019 at the Pike County Memorial Hospital in Louisiana, MO.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:00 am on Wednesday, November 20, 2019 at the St. Clement Catholic Church with Rev. Henry Ussher officiating. Burial will be in the St. Clement Cemetery. Visitation will be held from 8:00 am until time of services on Wednesday at the church.

Bee was born October 23, 1934, in Bowling Green, MO, the daughter of Frank and Catherine Grote Niemeyer. She married Melvin B. Meyer July 31, 1952. He survives.
