Lyndell Wayne Raufer, 71, of Hannibal, formerly of Bowling Green, passed away Wednesday, March 12, 2025, at Country View Nursing Facility in Bowling Green.

Funeral services for Lyndell will be held Tuesday, March 18, 2025, at 11:00 a.m. at Bibb-Veach Funeral Homes and Crematory in Bowling Green. Burial will be in Memorial Gardens Cemetery in Bowling Green. Visitation will be from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday at the funeral home.

Lyndell was born November 13, 1953, in Fort Leavenworth, Kansas to Phillip Wayne and Cecelia Sue (Travis) Raufer.

Lyndell spent most of his life in Bowling Green. In his youth, Lyndell was active in the Boy Scouts. He was a 1971 graduate of Bowling Green High School. Following graduation Lyndell joined the United States Navy in 1972, where he served on the USS Mataco. He was honorably discharged in 1974 from the San Diego Naval Station where he had served as an electrical repairman. After his discharge from the Navy, Lyndell went to work at Harbison Walker brick plant. He had also been employed with Townsend Tree Service and Arrow Industries.

Lyndell enjoyed fixing things, tinkering, and making jewelry. He loved rock and

roll music and was a fantastic mechanic. Lyndell was a jack-of-all-trades and had a great sense of humor. He was a football fan and always rooted for the Oakland Raiders. Lyndell was a loyal friend to many and will be missed by all who knew him.

Lyndell is survived by his daughter, Julie Raufer; granddaughter, Ryley Angel; sister, Glenda Coons; and a large extended family and many friends.

He was preceded in death by his parents and grandparents.

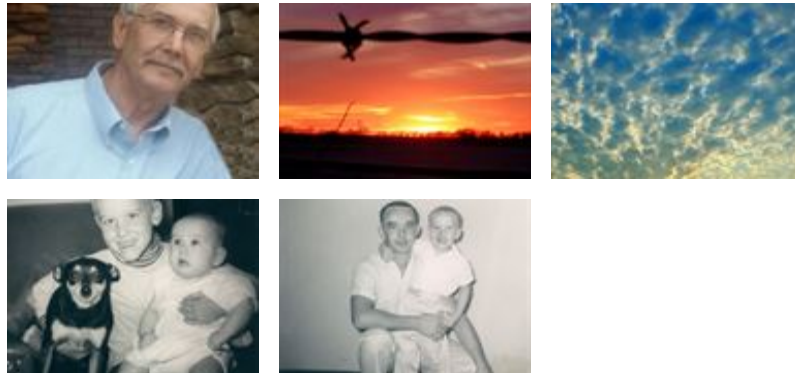

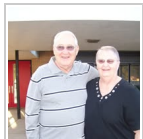
