Mabel Meyer, age 93, of Bowling Green passed away Thursday, September 22, 2016 at the St. Luke's Hospital West in Chesterfield.

A Funeral Mass will be held 10:00 a.m., Monday, September 26, 2016 at the St. Clement Catholic Church with Fr. Bill Peckman officiating. Burial will be in the St. Clement Cemetery. Visitation will be held 9:00 a.m. until time of service, Monday at the St. Clement Catholic Church.

Mabel was born May 20, 1923 in Clarksville, TN the daughter of Douglas and Nina Lee Chester Blankenship. On July 15, 1942 she married Robert Meyer. He preceded her in death on August 4, 1986.
