

Maburn Dean Coose

October 3, 1947 - March 19, 2020

Dean Coose, age 72, of rural Curryville, passed away Thursday, March 19, 2020 at this residence.

Visitation will be held on Tuesday, March 24, 2020 from 3:00 pm until 8:00 pm at the Bibb-Veach Funeral Home in Bowling Green. Private family funeral service will be held and burial will be in Evergreen Memorial Gardens Cemetery in Vandalia, MO.

Dean was born October 3, 1947 in Hannibal, MO, the son of Maburn D. and Anna Mae Silvey Coose. He married Sharon Ann Binning October 5, 1996, at the Elm Grove Baptist Church in Curryville, MO. She survives.
