Margie Irene Hamilton, 86, of Frankford, Missouri, passed away Sunday, November 25, 2018, at Country View Nursing Facility in Bowling Green, Missouri.

There will be a private Interment Service. Visitation will be from 4:00-6:00 PM, Thursday, November 29, 2018, at Frankford Presbyterian Church in Frankford, MO, with a Memorial Service to follow at 6:00 PM. The Rev. She and her family have been very active members in Frankford Presbyterian Church, where she has served as an elder, Clerk of Session, Sunday School Superintendent, Sunday School teacher, Bible School Director and teacher, and director of the annual Christmas program before her health failed. Margie will be remembered as the “life of everything”, full of mischief and fun! She loved all kinds of crafts and for many years, she arranged wildflowers each Sunday for her church. She was such a devoted and fun mother and grandmother, always putting her family first. She absolutely loved the Christmas season and was famous for her Christmas trees and “open-houses”, where many of the decorations were handmade by her.
