Mary Frances Gibson, 75, of Curryville, passed away Sunday, August 9, 2020 at her home, surrounded by her loving family.

Services for Mary are being planned and will be held at a later date.

Mary was born on August 13, 1944 in St. Louis, Missouri to Wincey and Elsie Webb Brown. She was married to Guy Gibson on April 10, 1976 at the First Baptist Church in Wentzville. He survives.

She loved her grandchildren, and her house was the house where all the kids and their friends wanted to be.
