Mary Louise Hall was born July 8, 1931 in New Hartford, MO to the late Augustus & Vena Luella Marie (Shepard) Hopke. She died Saturday, March 11, 2017 in Sulphur, Oklahoma, at the age of 85.

Mary grew up in New Hartford, where she attended elementary school. She later moved to Bowling Green, MO to attend high school, graduating in 1950.
