Millard Freeman, age 71 of Frankford, passed away at his residence Saturday, November 2, 2019.

Funeral services will be held at 2:00 pm on Tuesday, November 5, 2019 at the Bibb-Veach Funeral Home in Bowling Green with Rev. John Davis and Rev. Chad Summers officiating. Burial will be in the Fairview Cemetery in Louisiana, MO. Visitation will be held from 12:00 pm until 2:00 pm on Tuesday at the funeral home.

Millard was born July 2, 1948 in Flora, IL, the son of Richard Glenn and Vella Dale Harrison Freeman. He married Leota V. Francis June 17, 1985. She survives.

Millard enjoyed hunting and fishing. He especially enjoyed fishing with his grandchildren and great grandchildren. He always had an open-door policy and never knew a stranger. He loved people. Millard enjoyed piddling around in his shop and giving rides to the grandchildren on his side by side.

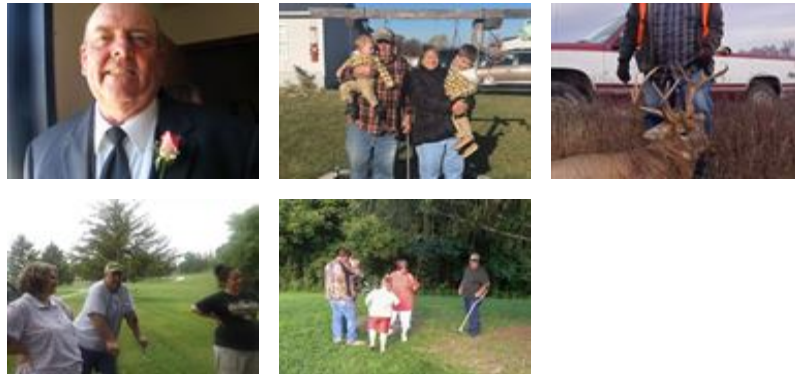
