Nellie Sue Pritchett Shaw passed away Tuesday, October 13, 2020 at Maple Lawn Nursing Home in Palmyra, Missouri

Private graveside services will be held Friday, October 16th at Fairview Cemetery with Rev. Gail Aurand officiating.

Nellie was born April 19, 1926 in Frankford, Missouri to Elmo and Thelma Scott Pritchett. On April 23, 1950 she was united in marriage to Emmett Shaw. This union was blessed with three children: Elmo Shaw of Frankford; Stephen (Cheryl) Shaw of Frankford; and Lynn (Dennis) Neff of Dawson, Illinois.

Nellie also participated in the Frankford quilting group and made many quilts for her children and grandchildren. She also enjoyed helping on the family farm in her free time.

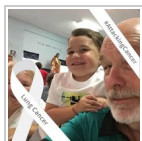
