Patricia Catherine Stanek, 70, of St. Louis, Missouri, passed away Wednesday, June 17, 2020 at Barnes Jewish Hospital in St. Louis.

A Memorial mass and burial will be held at St. Alphonsus Catholic Church and Millwood Cemetery at 10:00 a.m. on Monday, June 29, 2020, with Fr. Frank D'Amico officiating.

Patricia was born March 17, 1950 to Edward J. and Catherine Naomi Kohl Stanek in St. Charles, Missouri. She was united in marriage to Ron Freymuth at St. Alphonsus Catholic Church in 1972.
