Patsy Ann Branstetter-Grainge, age 95 of Louisiana, MO, passed away Monday, March 3, 2025, at Lynn's Heritage House in Louisiana.

Funeral services will be held at 11:00am, on Monday, March 10, 2025, at New Harmony Christian Church in Curryville, MO with Pastor Darin Clack officiating. Burial will be held in the New Harmony Cemetery. Visitation will be held from 9:30am, until the time of services on Monday, at the church.

Patsy was born at the family home in Curryville, MO, on December 17, 1929, the daughter of Harve Brooks and Mattie Mae (Mitchell) Branstetter. She grew up on the family farm and attended school locally.

Following school, she began working at the Tick Tock Café in Vandalia, MO, where she met her husband-to-be, thanks to his uncle Orville Henegar who made the introduction when Bob returned to the area after serving the United States Navy. She married Robert Grainge June 2, 1949, in Vandalia, MO. He preceded her in death on December 13, 1995.

Others preceding her in death were her parents; brothers John A., Bert, Elmer, Raymond, Richard, Joe, and Kemmie Branstetter; sisters Mary Frances Mudd and Ruby Nolan.

Patsy is survived by her sister Shirley Tredway of Louisiana, MO; several nieces and nephews; special friends in Tulsa, OK, including Melanie Dennis; Sandy (her “pretend daughter”) and her husband, Troy Sanstra.

Patsy started her married life in Hannibal, MO, where she worked in the shoe factory. They moved to Tulsa, OK, in 1951 where Bob continued his work in the insurance field and Patsy began her career as an Avon representative in 1962. She would continue selling Avon for the next 60 years, making the last delivery to her customers in February of 2022, just prior to moving to Missouri, where she resided at Lynn’s Heritage House in Louisiana, MO.
