Paul Andrew Redmond, 61, of Bowling Green passed away Thursday, March 26, 2026, due to injuries sustained in a motorcycle accident.

Funeral services will be held at 11:00am, Friday, April 10, 2026, at the Bibb-Veach Funeral Homes and Crematory in Bowling Green, MO with Rev. Mary Garrett officiating.
