



## Raymond F Eggert, Sr

June 18, 1929 - April 16, 2016

Raymond Frederick Eggert, Sr. passed away Saturday, April 16, 2016 at his home in rural Curryville. Funeral service will be held Friday at 11:00 am at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Vandalia with Fr. Mark Porterfield officiating. Interment will be in the Coldest Rock Cemetery (Family Cemetery) near Curryville. Visitation will be from 5:00 pm to 8:00 pm Thursday at the Bibb-Veach Funeral Home in Bowling Green.

Raymond was born on June 18, 1929 in Ferguson, the son of Fredrick Charles and Amelia (Kruessel) Eggert. He grew up in Black Jack and married Rose Marie Evans of Jennings on October 1, 1949. The couple then moved to Florissant. In 1970, they bought a farm near Curryville where they enjoyed spending weekends. Rose passed away on March 28, 1997 in Florissant. Surviving family include five children Steven (Debbie) Eggert of Wentzville, David (Chappell) Eggert of Winfield, Gary (Missy) Eggert of Winfield, Donna (Timothy) Sandifer of Alhambra, IL, Rosanne (Danny) Darnell of Florissant; many grandchildren and great grandchildren; daughter-in-law Sharron Eggert of Troy; and companion of 18 years, Maureen Selby of Curryville. He was preceded in death by son Raymond F. Eggert, Jr. and son-in-law Timothy P. Murphy.

In 1989, Captain Raymond F. Eggert, Sr. retired from the Black Jack Fire Department where he served for over 20 years. After the passing of his wife, Raymond eventually moved to their farm where he loved working the ground, planting crops, growing tomatoes, and hauling topsoil and rock for people. He

was a faithful parishioner at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Vandalia.
