Rhonda Rose Niemeyer of Bowling Green passed away September 25, 2025, at St Luke Hospital surrounded by family. Rhonda was born on March 2, 1955, to Victor Martin Niemeyer and Rose Ann Niemeyer (Orf).

Rhonda had a lifelong passion for working with the public. Her journey began as the proud owner and entrepreneur behind The Corner Deli & Pizza, a beloved local spot she ran with joy and dedication. After closing that chapter, she continued her commitment to service by joining Verizon in Wentzville, where she brought her trademark warmth and professionalism to every interaction.

Her devotion to community deepened when she joined the Pike County Sheriff's Office, contributing meaningfully to public safety and support. Rhonda later transitioned to the Pike County Recorder's Office, where she served as Deputy Recorder with integrity and care. She retired from this role on October 4, 2024, leaving behind a legacy of kindness, hard work, and unwavering public service.

A selfless woman with the kindest heart, she gave without hesitation and loved without limits. To her, no one was ever a stranger-just a friend she hadn't met yet. Her warmth radiated in every smile, every hug, every word of encouragement. Whether it was a neighbor in need or a passerby with a

heavy heart, she made everyone feel like they mattered. Her life was a quiet symphony of compassion, and the world is softer, brighter, and more loving because she was in it.

Rhonda, deeply devoted to family, found serenity in nature's subtleties-clouds, hummingbirds, and distant storms. Unlike others, she embraced the hum of traffic as a gentle lullaby, a rhythm that cradled her thoughts and dreams. She found peace in mowing her grass -its hum and scent a quiet therapy, each row a brushstroke on her canvas of calm.

Rhonda was the kind of grandmother whose calendar revolved around her grandkids' home games and concerts-rain or shine, she was there. Her cheers echoed from the bleachers and her proud smile lit up every auditorium. She didn't just attend-she celebrated every note, every score, every moment. The night sky awakened Rhonda's soul. Wrapped in a blanket, eyes lifted, she chased every celestial moment-meteor showers, satellites, space stations-no matter the hour, with butter crackers on her lap.

Rhonda's life was a gentle blend of earthly peace and celestial wonder-rooted in her garden's quiet blooms and serenaded by the Carpenters' Christmas Portrait on her cherished deck.

Rhonda's compassion didn't stop with people-she had a deep love for animals of all kinds. Whether it was a stray cat, a wandering dog, or even a curious raccoon, she welcomed them all. If an animal showed up at her doorstep, it never left hungry. Her kindness knew no boundaries, and her heart had room for every creature that crossed her path.

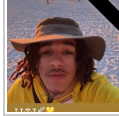
