



## Richard Joseph Corbin

Richard Joseph Corbin, age 80 of Silex, passed away Thursday, October 29, 2020 at his residence.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:00 am on Monday, November 2, 2020 at the St. Alphonsus Catholic Church with Fr. Charles Tichacek officiating.
