Robert Dale (Bob) Kuntz, 75, of Bowling Green, passed away peacefully Monday, November 4, 2024, at University Columbia Hospital with his loving wife, Patsy, by his side.

Funeral services will be held Thursday, November 7th at 1:30 p.m. at Adiel Baptist Church in Frankford with Bro. Randy McDonald officiating. Burial will be in the Fairview Cemetery in Louisiana. Visitation will be Wednesday, November 6th from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at Bibb-Veach Funeral Homes and Crematory in Bowling Green, and Thursday from 12:30 until the time of service at the church.
