



## Robert A. (Bob) Conrad

July 8, 1929 - March 28, 2019

Robert A. (Bob) Conrad, 89, passed away on March 28, 2019, at his home in rural Eolia.

Bob was born July 8, 1929 to John Frank and Jane Stephens Conrad of rural Clarksville. He was united in marriage on July 29, 1972, in Louisiana, Missouri to Annette Magee Windmiller, of Clarksville.

Bob grew up in the Dover neighborhood and attended grade school in Clarksville. He graduated in 1947 from Louisiana High School. After graduation, Bob attended the University of Missouri, studying agriculture, and was a walk-on member of the men's basketball team. Bob enlisted in the United States Navy, serving four years before being honorably discharged in January of 1955. He then returned to the family farm to assist his father in running the family farm operation.

Bob was elected to the office of Pike County Collector five times, serving 20 years in the position, from February 1979 to February 1999. He was a member of the Bowling Green Rotary Club with perfect attendance for 30 years and was a long time member of the Louisiana Elks Club, currently serving on the Trimble Hospital Board. Bob was a faithful member and deacon of the Edgewood Baptist Church, serving on various committees throughout the years. He was also a member of Gideon International.

Bob enjoyed hunting, fishing and collecting arrowheads. He found great joy in attending Clopton basketball games to watch family members play and coach, and was typically ready hours before the game, waiting to be picked up. In his later years, Bob enjoyed sightseeing trips with family and friends and seeing his children, grandchildren and great grandchildren whenever possible.

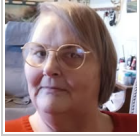
