Rodney B. Gamm, age 66, of Bowling Green, Missouri passed away at Pike County Memorial Hospital on Tuesday, January 16, 2024.

Funeral services for Rodney will be held Monday, January 22nd at 10:00 a.m. at Bibb-Veach funeral Homes and Crematory in Bowling Green with Rev. Jerry Gamm officiating. Burial will be in Memorial Gardens Cemetery. Visitation will be from 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, January 21st at the funeral home.

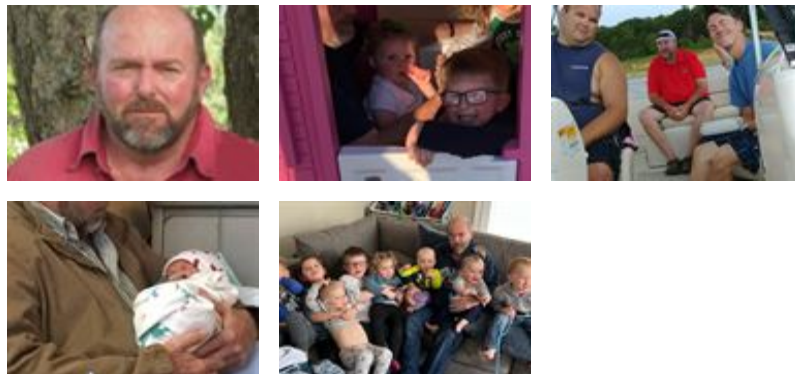

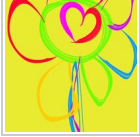
